Dr. Burk Parsons

Burk Hiram Parsons was born in Carmel, California, on March 14, 1976. He heard the gospel for the first time when he was 13 years old. By age 15 he was converted to Christ and immediately sensed God's call to gospel ministry. Dr. Parsons began serving on the staff of Sarasota Baptist Church in Sarasota, Florida, at the age of 19 while attending college. After graduating with a B.A. in biblical studies, he began his studies at Reformed Theological Seminary. In 1999, he began working for Ligonier Ministries, serving as the editor of *Tabletalk* magazine since 2003, and was appointed a Ligonier Ministries' Teaching Fellow in 2017.

After completing his pastoral internship in 2001 at St. Paul's Presbyterian Church, Dr. Parsons began serving at Saint Andrew's Chapel under Dr. R.C. Sproul (1939-2017). He is an ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church in America, a member of the Mission to North America Committee of the Central Florida Presbytery, and director of the Church Planting Fellowship. Dr. Parsons holds the Master of Divinity and Doctor of Ministry degrees from Reformed Theological Seminary where he serves as a visiting lecturer.

His doctoral dissertation is titled "The *Missio Dei* and the Church: Towards Fulfilling the Great Commission through Ordinary Means of Grace Ministry." He is author of *Why Do We Have Creeds?*, editor of *Assured by God: Living in the Fullness of God's Grace* and *John Calvin: A Heart for Devotion, Doctrine, and Doxology*, and cotranslator and coeditor of *A Little Book on the Christian Life* by John Calvin. He is also an associate editor of the *Reformation Study Bible*. He and his wife, Amber, were married in 2000 and live in Sorrento with their three children, Claire, Elizabeth, and Everett.

Dr. Derek Thomas

Derek W.H. Thomas, a native of Wales, is the Chancellor's Professor of Systematic and Pastoral Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary and also serves as Senior Minister at First Presbyterian Church (ARP) in Columbia, South Carolina. He previously served as the Chairman of the Theology Department at Reformed Theological Seminary (Jackson), the Minister of Teaching at First Presbyterian Church (PCA) in Jackson, Mississippi, and the Robert Strong Professor of Systematic and Pastoral Theology at Reformed Theological Seminary (Atlanta). He is also a Teaching Fellow with Ligonier Ministries. He holds a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics from the University of Wales, a Masters of Divinity from Reformed Theological Seminary (Jackson), and a Doctor of Philosophy from the University of Wales (Lampeter). He was ordained in the Evangelical Church of Ireland, and served Stranmillis Evangelical Presbyterian Church in Belfast for 17 years before moving to the United States. He has published more than twenty books and contributed to many others, including *How the Gospel Brings Us All the Way Home*, *Calvin's Teaching on Job*, and, with Dr. Sinclair B. Ferguson, *Ichthus: Jesus Christ, God's Son, the Saviour*.

WE AFFIRM THE "SOLAS" OF THE PROTESTANT REFORMATION

Sola Scriptura: The Bible is the sole written divine revelation and alone can bind the conscience of believers absolutely.

Sola Fide: Justification is by faith alone. The merit of Christ, imputed to us by faith, is the sole ground of our acceptance by God, by which our sins are remitted, and imputed to Christ.

Solus Christus: Christ is the only mediator through Whose work we are redeemed.

Sola Gratia: Our salvation rests solely on the work of God's grace for us.

Soli Deo Gloria: To God alone belongs the glory.
