AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Heidelberg Catechism #39-41

Minister: *Is it significant that He was "crucified" instead of dying some other way?*

People: Yes. This death convinces me that He shouldered the curse which lay on me, since death by crucifixion was accursed by God.

Minister: *Why did Christ have to go all the way to death?*

People: Because God's justice and truth demand it: only the death of God's Son could pay for our sin.

Minister: *Why was He buried?*

People: His burial testifies that He really died.
