AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Westminster Shorter Catechism #82-83

Minister: *Is any man able perfectly to keep the commandments of God?*

People: No mere man since the fall is able in this life perfectly to keep the commandments of God, but daily breaks them in thought, word, and deed.

Minister: *Are all transgressions of the law equally heinous?*

People: Some sins in themselves, and by reason of their nature and gravity, are more heinous in the sight of God than others.

The Second Commandment

Exodus 20:4-6

You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.
