AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Heidelberg Catechism #29-30

Minister: *Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning "savior?"*

People: Because He saves us from our sins. Salvation cannot be found in anyone else; it is futile to look for any salvation elsewhere.

Minister: *Do those who look for their salvation and security in saints, in themselves, or elsewhere really believe in the only savior Jesus?*

People: No. Although they boast of being His, by their deeds they deny the only savior and deliverer, Jesus. Either Jesus is not a perfect savior, or those who in true faith accept this savior have in Him all they need for their salvation.
