## AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Westminster Shorter Catechism #11–12

Minister: *What are God's works of providence?*

People: God's works of providence are, His most holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing all His creatures, and all their actions.

Minister: *What special act of providence did God exercise towards man in the state in which he was created?*

People: When God had created man, He entered into a covenant of life with him, upon condition of perfect obedience, forbidding him to eat of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, upon the pain of death.
