AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Westminster Shorter Catechism #88-90

Minister: *What are the outward and ordinary means by which Christ communicates to us the benefits of redemption?*

People: The outward and ordinary means by which Christ communicates to us the benefits of redemption are, His ordinances, especially the Word, sacraments, and prayer; all which are made effectual to the elect for salvation.

Minister: *How is the word made effectual to salvation?*

People: The Spirit of God makes the reading, but especially the preaching of the Word, an effectual means of convincing and converting sinners, and of building them up in holiness and comfort through faith unto salvation.

Minister: *How is the word to be read and heard, that it may become effectual to salvation?*

People: That the word may become effectual to salvation, we must attend to it with diligence, preparation, and prayer; receive it with faith and love, lay it up in our hearts, and practice it in our lives.
