AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Westminster Shorter Catechism #91-93

Minister: *How do the sacraments become effectual means of salvation?*

People: The sacraments become effectual means of salvation, not from any virtue in them, or in him that does administer them; but only by the blessing of Christ, and the working of His Spirit in them that by faith receive them.

Minister: *What is a sacrament?*

People: A sacrament is a holy ordinance instituted by Christ, in which, by sensible signs, Christ and the benefits of the new covenant are represented, sealed, and applied to believers.

Minister: *Which are the sacraments of the New Testament?*

People: The sacraments of the New Testament are, baptism, and the Lord's supper.
